

2000 PREP INCIDENTS

August 30, 2000 – Haz-Response Inc. deployed 200 feet of containment boom to protect a golf course watershed. A tank truck, carrying road oil, entered the golf course pond and released approximately 150 gallons of product into the waterway. The boom was positioned and anchored to the banks to contain the spilled oil. Absorbents were used to recover the product. HMR personnel included L. Horne, D. Wise, D. McWilliams, B. Waln, D. Smith and B. Becker

December 4, 2000 – Haz-Mat Response, Inc. deployed 1000 feet of containment boom in the Ninnescha River, southwest of Cheney, KS. The boom was positioned in several configurations during the training exercise. Skimming devices were positioned and Vacuum truck operations were simulated. Boat and bank deployment, along with anchoring techniques, were included in the operation. K. Simmons, D. Sommers, W. King, S. Fromme, B. Hoy, S. Bradley, A. Gremmel and M. McCandles participated in the exercise.

Haz-Mat Response, Inc. owned and dedicated equipment was used during the incident and drill.
